Regular and punctual school attendance is important. Pupils need to attend school regularly if they are to take full advantage of the educational opportunities available to them by law. The last published national average for school attendance was 96%. Nawton Community Primary School's attendance target is 97%. Our attendance this week is 98% - a really positive start to the year!
