

CLASS 4 – YEAR 5 AND 6:**CLASS 3 REMOTE LEARNING OFFER:**

READING	<p>The children are expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes reading for pleasure each day. The children have access to Oxford Owl ebook to supplement books at home. In addition to this they will read as part of a small group guided reading session at least once a week for half an hour through Teams.</p> <p>1:1 reading sessions are provided to support target readers. Class stories – each day the teacher will share a story live through Teams where possible.</p>
WRITING	<p>Children have a daily English lesson. A unit of work is approx 2 weeks and will be based on a text/book/novel/film/image. Children are set a range of writing outcomes: e.g. descriptive writing, report writing, poetry. Discrete grammar and punctuation sessions are taught weekly live through Teams.</p> <p>There will also be opportunities to write across the curriculum. Feedback will be given on spelling, grammar and composition to help children improve.</p>
PHONICS/ SPELLING	<p>Daily phonics sessions through Teams for target children.</p> <p>A list of spelling words to learn will be provided each week along with activities to support with learning these words. Spellings sent home on Monday/Weekly spelling test on Friday</p>
MATHEMATICS	<p>The White Rose Maths scheme is followed through school and White Rose Maths published home learning videos and resources that link to the same sequence of lessons being used in school are used daily.</p> <p>The daily Maths lesson will be delivered through Teams. Daily maths activities are modelled by the teacher using the correct vocabulary, through a live teach or a pre recorded session. Children complete a similar task at home and send photos or videos to Class Dojo.</p> <p>Times Tables Rockstar/ Numbots – The children are expected to spend 20minutes per day practicing and consolidating their times tables and number bonds.</p> <p>Additional maths support available throughout the day if requested via Teams.</p>
SCIENCE	<p>Science topics will be taught via Microsoft Teams once a week and home investigations set where applicable.</p>
HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY	<p>Taught via Microsoft Teams, and with resources available to support.</p>
COMPUTING	<p>Taught through the online platform Purple Mash.</p>
ART/DT	<p>Taught via Microsoft Teams, and with resources available to support.</p>
RE	<p>Taught via Microsoft Teams, and with resources available to support.</p>
FRENCH	<p>Children able to access online videos to support pronunciation. Lessons/activities delivered on Teams</p>
PSHE	<p>Taught via Microsoft Teams, and with resources available to support.</p>
PE	<p>Focuses on personal targets and health and fitness and healthy lifestyles. Challenges and activities provided online by Hawkes and North Yorkshire Sport. Children able to take part in virtual competition 'Ultimate Warrior'</p>
Music	<p>Taught via Microsoft Teams, and with resources available to support.</p>
